Sessions



1. Assessment

Learn to evaluate disciples' readiness. Are they thriving in all areas of life? How are they making disciples at home, at work, and among friends? Can they apply God's truth to everyday situations? Do they use their gifts to serve God and others?



2. Spiritual Formation

Based on the disciples' assessment, personalize a discipleship process to help them grow in spiritual maturity, personal/family/financial stability, biblical worldview, cross-cultural issues, and ministry preparedness.



3. Mentoring

Develop a structure for mature believers to come alongside the disciples in an atmosphere of grace and truth.



4. Ministry Experience

Give the disciples opportunities to practice the things they learn in real-life settings, such as serving in their giftedness, discipling others, leading a small group, or engaging in cross-cultural opportunities here and abroad.
